**FIELD PLACEMENT INTERNSHIP  
2009-2010**

The internship program at the C. G. Jung Institute of Los Angeles offers clinical training at the Kieffer Frantz Clinic for adults. Opportunity for training at the Hilde Kirsch Children's Center is available to qualified interns who are accepted into the program through the adult clinic.

The program formally begins late September. However, the intern may elect to begin as early as June. In either case, the time commitment for the internship is 12 continuous months. There is no stipend, nor is there any training fee.

Clinic experience consists of 8-12 cases, one hour of individual supervision and two hours of group supervision per week. In addition, the intern will be required to attend selected seminars and meetings at the Institute.

**Requirements:** Applicant must currently be enrolled in a doctoral program in clinical psychology or have already completed a master's degree. Internship hours may be counted toward the psychology license or toward the M.F.T. license. Applicant must have completed 100 hours of analysis with a certified Jungian analyst and have had two years of clinical experience before beginning the internship. In addition, the intern must continue to be in weekly personal Jungian analysis during the internship.

**Application:** Please complete the enclosed application, verification of analytic hours, obtain two personal references and have them send letters directly to the Institute. At least one letter must be from your current or a previous supervisor. In addition to those letters, please have your personal analyst sign the attached verification of hours of analysis. Deadline for all application material: **March 2, 2009**
